

JAY MOSKOWITZ

Jay Moskowitz is the Director, Standards Developer Audit Program. He was hired by American National Standards Institute (ANSI) in 1995 to implement a new standards developer Audit Program. This ANSI Audit Program is charged with auditing some 240 ANSI-accredited standards developers on a five-year cycle and has conducted approximately 700 audits to date.

Jay's primary role relates to managing the SDO Audit Program. He hires and trains ANSI Auditors who conduct procedural audits and conducts audits periodically himself. He oversees the entire audit process from scheduling audits on a yearly basis to reviewing audit reports and transmittal letters offering suggestions for improvements as well as participating in all conference calls and finally conveying the decisions on audits by the reviewing body, the ANSI Executive Standards Council (ExSC), to the standards developer.

Prior to joining ANSI he was employed by the U.S. Navy as a management analyst for ten years. When working for the U.S. Navy, Jay was charged with managing its internal review program. This program detected waste, fraud, abuse and mismanagement in the Federal Government. Jay is experienced in conducting management control reviews and internal audits.

He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Business Management from Baruch College in New York.
