

- A Quick Way to Expand Your Professional Contacts

Sample Discussion Questions

- 2. Where do you work?

- 4. What are your career goals?
- 5. Why did you get into your current field?
- 6. Did you need any specialized training?
- 7. Do you have any ASQ Certifications?
- 8. What is the most challenging aspect of your current job?
- 9. What do you love most about your job?
- 10. What are some of your career challenges?
- 11. What advice would you give to someone who is interested in your field?
- 12. Where do you see yourself in 5 years?
- 13. Do you plan to stay in your career field or try to break into a new one?
- 14. Which of your current skills would you like to draw upon most in the next phase of your career?



Ground Rules for Speed Networking

Have fun! The fast pace of this kind of event contributes to a high level of energy in the room.
Allow 2-5 minutes for each round; the leader will inform the group about the time frame.
As you meet each person exchange names and business cards.
Introduce yourself and begin to tell one another your story.
Be extremely aware of the time line so each person has the opportunity to speak.
Take notes on the back of your partner's business card for later review
Respect the process by ending your conversation after the bell and move onto the next person.
