

 Quite the comprehensive medicine!
- Electro-Voltaic Belt: to men afflicted with nervous debility, loss of vitality and all kindred troubles. Also for Rheumatism, neuralgia, paralysis, and many other diseases.
- Munyon's Paw-Paw Pills: "They coax the liver into activity, they invigorate instead of weaken, & they enrich the blood instead of impoverishing it".
 - (Corrects constipation.)

1883 - Dr. Wiley comes to Washington

- Food / Drug rules regulated by states
- Adulteration & misbranding increased by late 1800's
- Wiley expanded research in this area
- Concerned over chemical preservatives in food

1906 - Pure Food and Drug Act

- Forbade commerce of adulterated / misbranded food & drugs
- Seized & condemned offending products
- Offending persons could be fined & jailed
- Accurate label statements
- Alcohol / Narcotic presence must be stated on the label

1937 - Sulfanilamide

- > 7 to 21 days of symptoms
 - stoppage of urine,
 - severe abdominal pain,
 - nausea,
 - vomiting,
 - stupor, and convulsions.
 - intense pain.
 - No known antidote or treatment for diethylene glycol poisoning.



1937 - Sulfanilamide

> 108 deaths


Company was charged with misbranding.



1938 - Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act

- New drug application (NDA) required showing drug safety.
- Safe tolerances set for unavoidable poisonous substances
- Directions for use and warnings about possible misuse also required unless the drug was sold by prescription
- Authorized factory inspections

Thalidomide



Kefauver-Harris Amendments

- Drug manufacturers must provide information on a drug's effectiveness as well as its safety
- Mandated record keeping
- 60-day review period eradicated
- Permitted FDA to withdraw approval
- Teratogenic testing required
- Clinical trial patient consent

Milestones

- 1962 cGMP's Established in CFR for Drug Manufacture.
- 1978 Major revisions to the cGMP's dealing with personnel & facilities, as well as products and processes.
- 1995 Proposed updates to cGMP's stalled
- 1997 FDA Modernization Act globalized industry requires consistent and efficient regulatory requirements

cGMP's

- Write procedures and work instructions
- Follow procedures and instructions
- Document your work
- Validate / Qualify processes and equipment
- Design proper facilities & equipment.
- Maintain and cleanse facilities, equipment & self
- Define, develop & demonstrate job competence
- Protect against contamination
- Control components & product related processes
- Conduct planned & periodic audits

Quality Systems Approach

- Six System Inspection Approach
 - Quality System
 - Facilities & Equipment Systems
 - Production System
 - Materials System
 - Packaging & Labeling System
 - Laboratory Controls System

2004 - Risk-Based Approach

- High Risk Products & Processes
 - Sterile drugs, aseptic filtration, prescription drugs
- High Risk Facilities
 - New facilities, First application, Warning letter recipients, Sterile product manufacturers, Recalls
- Encourage technological Advances
- Train FDA on regulating technological advancement
